Tierra Vista Village HOA Home Owner Responsibilities

(Reference Legal Documents For Details)

- Abide by the HOA Rules and Regulations, By-Laws and all other provisions of the Tierra Vista Village HOA.
- · Pay HOA monthly fees assessed quarterly.
- Pay/reimburse annual prorated insurance for exterior of private property to HOA and maintain private insurance for the internal property. Pay county property taxes. These are owner expenses.
- All General Common Element (GCE) belong to all HOA members, including front yards, streets and walls, and are maintained collectively by all the members. Thus, GCE may not be altered by any individual. Limited Common Element (LCE) as designated by the Plat on a survey's report are to be maintained by each HOA Member Unit. Changes to LCE must be approved by the board prior to construction.
- Submit change requests to HOA for any exterior alternations on the exterior Unit or LCE private property. Drawings/pictures must be approved by the board and contractors must be properly bonded.
- Remove snow from driveway and sidewalk.
- No parking in common overnight parking when snow is plowed. Vehicles parked in common areas may be towed at owner's expense.
- Store trash in the garage. Put trash and recycling out after 6 AM on trash day.
- Maintain Private Property, including utility lines. Watering and mowing private property. Failure can result in fines.
- Maintain the exterior property and fence according to HOA policies.
- Use Messmers UV Plus Natural stain for fences and house. Any exception require HOA approval.

By member vote, special assets may apply.
